



20mm Pissoir and Benches

B20-ST-111

Please read these instructions fully before starting construction.

PVA or equivalent glue will be required to stick sections together.

Sand paper can be used to gently clean any joints.

A sharp modelling knife will be required to remove sections from the sprue. Please use knives with due care and remember to cut away from yourself at all times.

During the construction of this model, you may find it convenient to use pegs / elastic bands to hold pieces in place while you allow glue to dry.

The central column starts with the pieces shown above. Note the small hexagon and the "cog" are the same size.



Glue the two larger hexagons together and insert the spindle through both pieces. To ensure pieces are the right way round make sure the sprue points are on the same side.



Next glue the "cog" into place.




Then attach the arms so that the long edge is resting on the base as shown.




Lock these into place by adding the small hexagonal piece (again ensure you align the sprue point).



Glue the remaining hexagons onto the spindle.



Next remove the six strips from the sprue.



Attach the two largest hexagons to the spindle and top these with the small hexagons. Glue one strip to the centre of each side of the column as shown.




Remove the six oblongs and their frames from the sprue.



Glue an oblong to each of the arms with the hole towards the bottom (see above).




Glue a frame to each oblong.



Each of the long walls is formed from the pieces shown above.



Glue these together as shown so the etched detail is all on the outer face.




The two smaller walls use these pieces.



And go together as above.




Attach the walls to the base using the holes provided.



Finally glue the central column into place using the hexagon on the base as a guide.



Glue the base and back to one end piece.



Each bench is formed from the four pieces shown.
Note the lug on the "back" is not central.



Then glue the other end into place.
