



8mm Chapel Ruin

Please read these instructions fully before starting construction.

PVA or equivalent glue will be required to stick sections together.

Sand paper can be used to gently clean any joints.

A sharp modelling knife will be required to remove sections from the sprue. Please use knives with due care and remember to cut away from yourself at all times.

During the construction of this model, you may find it convenient to use pegs / elastic bands to hold pieces in place while you allow glue to dry.

Please refer to the separate "B08-FG-xxx Components" instruction sheet for details on how to make the individual component pieces.



Gather the components shown above.



Glue them together as shown.



Take these components.



Glue them to the building as shown.



Take these pieces.



Glue them to the tower, then add the pieces to make the fourth side.



insert a floor piece into the top of the tower.




Construct this section.

Note – if you wish this wall to be to the right of the tower rather than the left, glue the columns to the opposite side.



Glue the wall to the left of the tower.




The side walls are made from these components.



Glue them together as shown.




Add them to the building.



Remove **ONE** of the inserts from each floor piece.



Glue them into place.



Construct the rear wall.



Glue it into position.



Cut one of the strips as shown above.



Glue it to the column in the centre of the building.



Take the buttress pieces.



Work around the bottom of the building, gluing the buttresses into place on the columns.



Take the edging strips.




Cut another of the strips as shown above.



Take the strips from the balustrade kit.



Take the short strips.



Cut short strips to fit where columns have been placed next to ruined walls / windows.



Work around the building, glueing these into place.



Glue this into the column shown above.



Glue these into place where balustrades join large columns. (shown on the non-ruined chapel)



Glue these to the short columns. columns. (shown on the non-ruined chapel)



The completed building.
