20mm Ruins #7 – Corner Balcony

B20-RU-007

Please read these instructions fully before starting construction.

PVA or equivalent glue will be required to stick sections together.

Sand paper can be used to gently clean any joints.

A sharp modelling knife will be required to remove sections from the sprue. Please use knives with due care and remember to cut away from yourself at all times.

During the construction of this model, you may find it convenient to use pegs / elastic bands to hold pieces in place while you allow glue to dry.

We recommend you paint portions of this model prior to construction – please see below for details.



Remove the two inner wall sections, the base and balcony from the sprue.



Attach the balcony to one wall piece, then slide the other into position. Glue the whole assembly to the base.



Take the two rear wall pieces.



And glue them to the model.



The balustrade and handrail.



Attach the larger balustrade piece.



Followed by the smaller one and the handrail.



The supports and doorframes.



Glue the doorframes into position and attach the supports (anywhere you feel is aesthetically pleasing)



The finished item.

Before construction, we sprayed the stonework portions of our model with a matt black car undercoat aerosol, then applied a heavy drybrush of a dark blue/grey colour emulsion.

After that had dried we applied a lighter drybrush of a pale grey colour, then followed this by a very light drybrush of an almost white emulsion.

All our emulsion paints are DIY store colour-test pots.

All the wooden sections were left as they were (i.e. bare MDF)
