

# 28mm Wild West Church Furniture

## B28-AF-100

**BLOTZ**

Please read these instructions fully before starting construction.

PVA or equivalent glue will be required to stick sections together.

Sand paper can be used to gently clean any joints.

A sharp modelling knife will be required to remove sections from the sprue. Please use knives with due care and remember to cut away from yourself at all times.

During the construction of this model, you may find it convenient to use pegs / elastic bands to hold pieces in place while you allow glue to dry.

For the table, remove the pieces shown above from the sprue. First apply a little glue to the top bar of the two end pieces and stick to the table top, aligning the holes / lugs.



Secondly, apply a little glue to each end of the bar and attach to the notches in the end pieces.




The cross is formed from the pieces shown above. Stick the smaller square on top of the larger square so that the holes align. Insert the base of the cross into the hole.



Remove the candles and their holders from the sprue. Glue the base of each candle into its holder.




Finally glue the cross and candles to the table as shown above.



The bookcase is formed from the pieces shown above. Firstly apply glue to one shelf and insert it into the central hole. Use this to align the two end pieces.



Finally insert the lower shelf and top shelf.



Each pew is formed from the pieces shown above. The wider of the two horizontal pieces forms the backrest of the pew. The other is the seat.



Start by attaching the backrest and seat to one of the pew, then using the lugs, align the other end of the pew.
