



28mm Sci-Fi Walls – 95mm Door #1

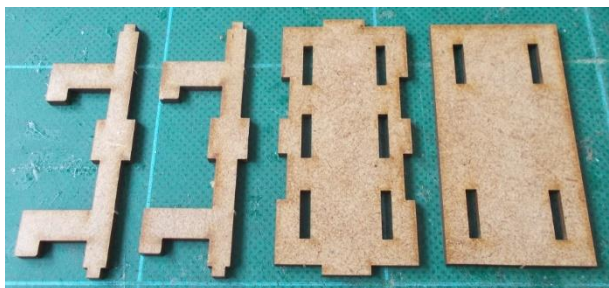
Please read these instructions fully before starting construction.

PVA or equivalent glue will be required to stick sections together.

Sand paper can be used to gently clean any joints.

A sharp modelling knife will be required to remove sections from the sprue. Please use knives with due care and remember to cut away from yourself at all times.

During the construction of this model, you may find it convenient to use pegs / elastic bands to hold pieces in place while you allow glue to dry.



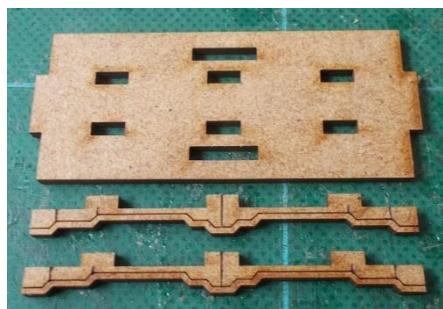
Each end of the wall is formed from the pieces shown above.



Glue the two hooked pieces through the back plate, ensuring the hooks all point in the same direction.



Add the outer later.
Repeat this for the other end piece.



Take the inner wall and two of the strips shown above.



Add the inner wall to the assembly you have already made.



Add the strips with the etched detail facing outwards.



Take the wall pieces shown above.



Take the roof and long strips

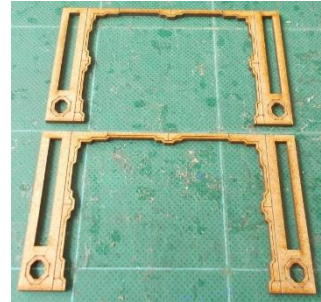
Glue one assembly to each end of the base (hooks facing downwards) and add a wall strip to each side (as shown above) with the horizontal line at the bottom.



Glue the strips to the roof.



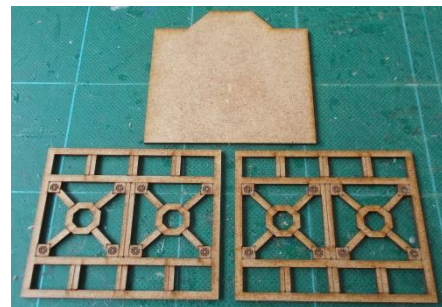
Glue the roof into place (note the strips go on the inside of the model)



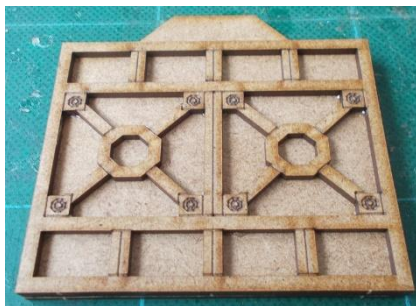
Take the two outer decorative pieces.



Glue these into place on each side of the model.



The door is formed from the pieces shown above.



Glue the girder panels on each side of the door, ensuring the edges align. Leave to dry.



Place (do not glue) the door into the space in the model.
